

BCYSSL Youth to Youth Permits (Revised for 2007-2008)

- a) The Select League shall grant a registered Select League player permission to play for a Select League team **in an older age division**.
- b) The Select League shall grant a player registered with a team outside the League permission to play for a Select League team **of his age group or older age division**.
- c) The Select League shall grant a player registered with a 'B Division Select League' team permission to play for the same-age 'A Division Select League' team with which his team is formally associated, and shall grant an 'A Division Select League' team permission to play for the same-age 'B Division Select League' team with which his team is formally associated.

(Each 'A Division' team can only formally associate with one same-age 'B Division' team, and vice versa. Teams must register their associate with the League prior to the season. A Select League team operated by a club can only associate with a team from the same club; a Select League team directly operated by a Youth District can only associate with another team directly operated by that district.)

- d) Permission is contingent on the player receiving the **consent of the team and the approval of the Youth District** with which he is registered.
- e) A Select League team operated by a club can only obtain players from its own club's teams; a Select League team operated by a Youth District can obtain players from teams in its own District.
- f) Permits will be allowed for **league games only**, not for any cup games.
- g) Registered Out-of-District players and players under suspension shall not be eligible to play under permit. The only exception is that Out-of-District players can play on permit for their formally associated same-age team, **only subject to any team playing a maximum of three (3) Out-of-District players in any game**.
- h) Any player requesting a permit must apply for permission by completing a permit form supplied by the League. The application form bearing the consent of the releasing team must be submitted for the Youth District Designate's consideration **prior to the game** for which the permit is requested. Youth Districts may set additional conditions for approval of the league's permits and may elect not to approve any league permits.
- i) A permit is **valid only for the team, day and game stated** on the permit application form.
- j) An approved permit form for the permitted player must be presented to the game official and to the opposing coach prior to the start of the game. Any player with a permit must also present a valid ID card to be eligible to play.
- k) Teams shall not be granted permits for more than three players for any one- league game, except that permits between same-age associated A/B division teams are unlimited, and do not count as part of the 'three-player' limit.
- l) A player shall not play on a Select League permit more than four times in one season, except that permits between same-age associated A/B teams are unlimited.
- m) Any **disciplinary action** applied from misconduct reported while playing in a game under permit shall be served during the very next game(s) with his/her registered team. (See also g).
- n) Any team playing a player on a permit that does not conform to the above Rules shall be sanctioned as for playing an ineligible player, and have Permit Privileges withdrawn. Any district approving permits not conforming to the above rules shall be sanctioned by withdrawal of permit privileges for its District for up to one year.
